Everyone, please remove your hat during the Pledge of Allegiance, National Anthem, and during entertainment.

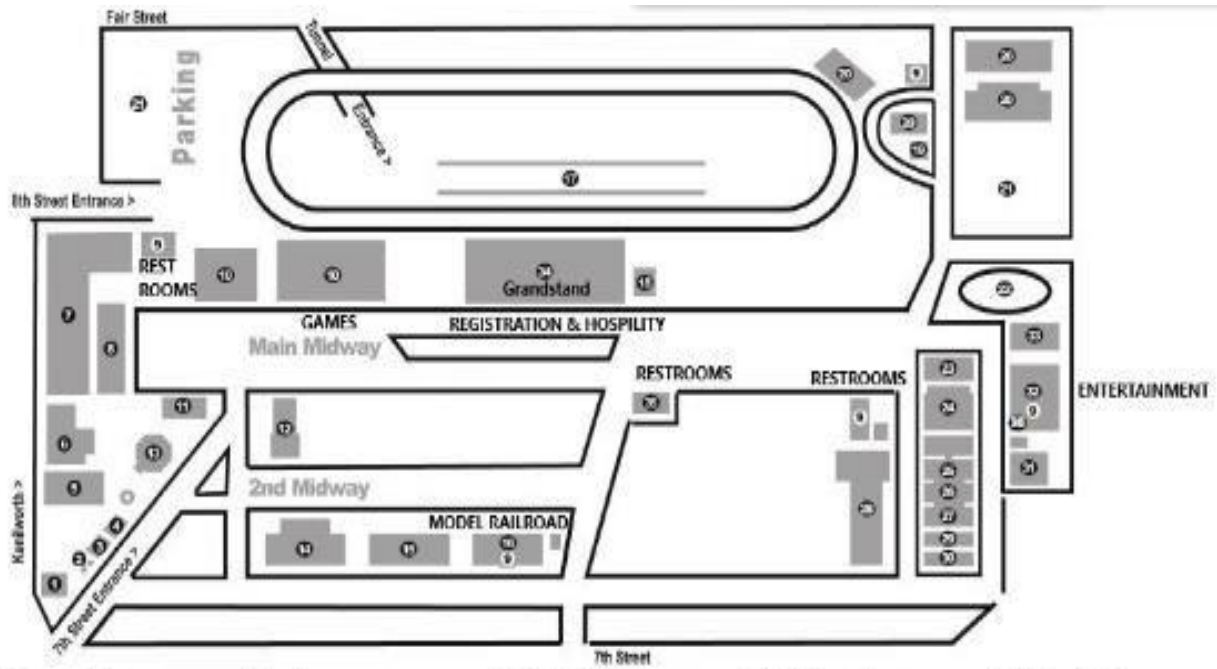
We continue to collect non-perishable food items for the local food pantries along with can tabs, eye glasses & yarn.
