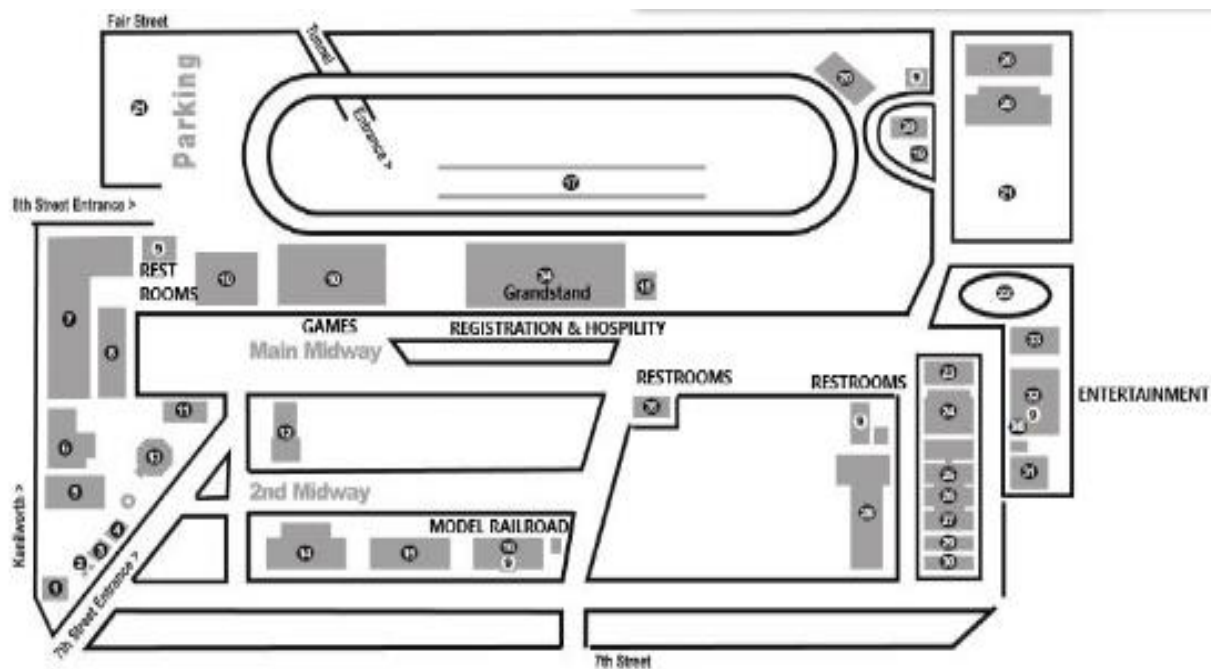

NO SMOKING in or near building entrances and exits. All pets must be on a leash at all times. **Pets are not allowed** in any building. (please see Diane Gottschalk if you have a service animal). **PLEASE, CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET. Chairs** - Bring a chair to evening entertainment and beanbag baseball. **Chair set up on Thursday immediately following SAMGO for evening entertainment will take place. Once the chairs are set up, they will be left set up as long as we are tidy and don't leave messes to be cleaned up afterwards. REMEMBER WE ARE TRYING THE HONOR SYSTEM however, you must adhere to fire safety regulations.** If your group wants to set your chairs up together, please bring enough people to accomplish this. We request that you not use chairs that have legs that protrude beyond the seat of the chair (trip hazard); chairs with taller backs (so everyone can see). (You may use these chairs in the back rows and sides provided you are not blocking access.) **WE MUST KEEP AISLES OPEN AND CLEAR FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE. Everyone, please silence your phones** during events and entertainment. If you need to take a call, we ask that you go to another room or outside. **Everyone, please remove your hat** during the Pledge of Allegiance, National Anthem, and during entertainment. **We continue to collect non-perishable food items for the local food pantries along with can tabs, eye glasses & yarn. Dump stations are available.** Locations will be announced along with signage. **Reminder: Do not move your rig once you have been parked without notifying a member of the parking crew. EMERGENCY NUMBERS AND INFORMATION CALL 911. Tell them that you are at the COSHOCTON COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS and that someone will meet them at the Fair Board Office Gate to direct them to your location.
