Programs are posted in each of the buildings **along with a map of the fairground, hospital locations and emergency phone numbers.**

NO SMOKING in or near building entrances and exits. The smoke flows into the building and is unpleasant for nonsmokers.

Pets - All pets must be on a leash at all times with a human at the other end. **All pets must be registered with the Fairgrounds per Hardin County Health Department rules.** Pets are **not allowed** in any building (please see Director if you have a service animal). **PLEASE, CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET and avoid disposing the bags in the trash near food buildings.**

Chairs - Bring a chair to evening entertainment and beanbag baseball. Fold your chairs up and stack them against the walls until chair set up on **Thursday at 3:00 pm AFTER SAMGO. Once the chairs are set up, they will be left set up as long as we are tidy and don't leave messes to be cleaned up afterwards.** If your group wants to set your chairs up together, please bring enough people to set up the chairs to expedite the process. *We request that you not use chairs that have legs that protrude beyond the seat of the chair (trip hazard); chairs with taller backs (so everyone can see); and no rockers. *(You may use these chairs in the back rows and sides provided you are not blocking access.)* **WE MUST KEEP AISLES OPEN AND CLEAR FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE.**

Vendors - Please visit the vendors. They are open daily from 9 am – 3 pm and Saturday 9 am-1 pm.

Everyone, please silence your phones during events and entertainment. If you need to take a call, we ask that you go to another room or outside.

Everyone, please remove your hat during the Pledge of Allegiance, National Anthem, and during entertainment. Please remember to show respect for our Flag and Country.

We continue to collect non-perishable food items for the local food pantries along with can tabs, eye glasses & yarn.

Dump stations are available. Locations will be announced along with signage.

Reminder: Do not move your rig once you have been parked without notifying a member of the parking crew.

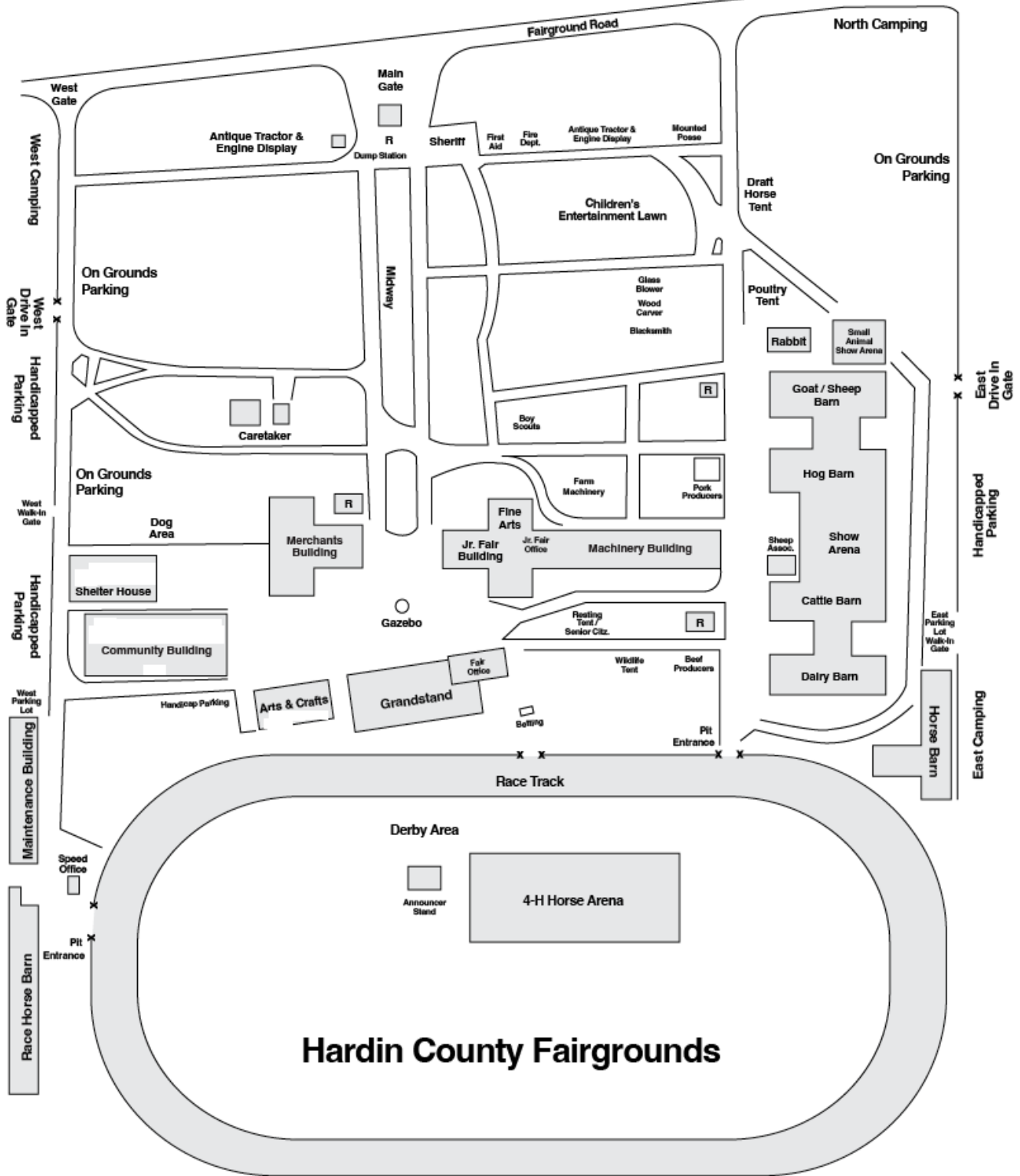
