Once the chairs are set up, they will be left set up as long as we are tidy and don't leave messes to be cleaned up afterwards.** If your group wants to set your chairs up together, please bring enough people to set up the chairs to expedite the process. \*We request that you not use chairs that have legs that protrude beyond the seat of the chair (trip hazard); chairs with taller backs (so everyone can see); and no rockers. (You may use these chairs in the back rows and sides provided you are not blocking access.) **WE MUST KEEP AISLES OPEN AND CLEAR FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE.** 

**Vendors** - Please visit the vendors. They are open daily from 9 am – 3 pm and Saturday 9 am-1 pm. as available.

**Everyone, please silence your phones** during events and entertainment. If you need to take a call, we ask that you go to another room or outside.

**Everyone, please remove your hat** during the Pledge of Allegiance, National Anthem, and during entertainment. Please remember to show respect for our Flag and Country.
